As we work through the next few weeks, it is our goal to continue classroom instruction and support students to the best of our ability at Spalding High School. We are including on our website several items to provide you with as much information as possible during this time. We also have several support systems in place to facilitate Digital Student Learning: daily learning goals, timelines for student work completion, virtual teacher/counselor access, and school administrator(s) available via email (8:00 AM - 4:00 PM; Mon- Fri.).

Online Learning Starts Wednesday, March 18th, on Google Drive. Students that do not have opportunity for internet based learning were given hard copies of work on Friday March 13th before they left school. If your child was absent, you can call the school and set up a time to drive through and pick up the packet.

Students should:

1. Check in each day to their Google Classroom or work on hard packet copy following the daily plan of work.
 - a. Teachers will be available on Google Classroom for questions, guidance and assistance with daily assignments.
 - i. Submit work according to teacher guidance for each of their Google Classrooms.
 - b. Students with a hard copy packet should work with parents, siblings and others within the household to do the best they can with the work in the packet.
 - i. You can email any teachers, counselors or administrators if you have access for questions and guidance. See Google Classroom Class Code Directory for teacher emails.
 - ii. Hold on to all completed hard copy work until students return to school.
 - iii. Make the best effort you can and work should be seen that you attempted to do the work.
2. Google Classroom- Each teacher has a google classroom for students to get work and interact with the teacher on-line for questions about the work.
 - a. Google Classroom Master Directory is available to see all teachers on their Google Classroom Codes to access student work on our website.
