Proof of acceptance/enrollment in the post-secondary institution will be required.

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants must be a graduating SHS senior with a minimum 2.5 grade point average and planning to enroll in the fall at an accredited two or four year college, university, or technical institution. Academic need may be considered.

Applicants must complete the application in its entirety. Please include the following with your application:
